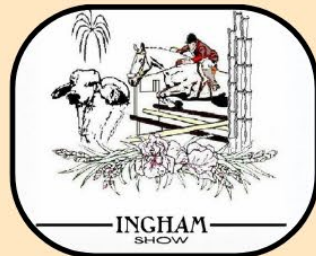

# 2026 Cattle Program

## **Prime Beef, Herd, Penned Stud, Junior Handlers, Junior Judging, Led Steer / Heifer, Led Stud Bull / Female.**

### GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Nomination forms and entries are open from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2026 and will close once pens are full or by the 19<sup>th</sup> of June 2026.
- Please forward all nomination forms and stud registration certificates to [inghamshow@bigpond.com](mailto:inghamshow@bigpond.com) or brooke.e.larsen05@gmail.com. This is to ensure adequate space for all exhibitors.
- Nominations are to be in by 19/06/2026 at 5pm.
- Entries are preferably taken through email or alternatively you can hand nomination forms into the show office.
- All entry monies must be paid when nominating. We will not be chasing anyone up. If you haven't paid you will not be entered into preferred classes.
- All direct deposits must have a clear reference on them (Your full name). We do not hold any responsibility for lost moneys or tracking unidentified payments down.
- Please send all remittance to [inghamshow@bigpond.com](mailto:inghamshow@bigpond.com).
- Pen allocations will be available on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> of June 2026.
- All cattle must arrive by Thursday morning at 10am (25/06/26). No cattle are to depart from the Showgrounds prior to Friday 26/06/26 5pm.
- All cattle must comply with NVD & NLIS requirements.
- Required information will be NVD, NLIS read mob no, Animal health Declaration Form and Waiver form.
- All exhibitors are to be responsible for their stock including feeding and watering.
- Please note there are only limited water troughs in the yards so please bring your own watering buckets.
- The committee does not undertake to care for cattle exhibited and will not be held responsible for any injury, sickness or losses.
- Judging of Parading cattle will commence approx. 1pm Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> of June 2026 and Prime, Herd and Penned Stud will commence judging at 8am Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026 and Junior Judging will commence at 9:30am Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026.
- To compete in an age class competition, you must be that age on that day.
- All Led animals over 6 months of age must have a nose ring or clip attached when handled on grounds.
- Entry fees are as follows (Prime cattle- \$15 per class) (Herd cattle- \$15 per class) (Penned Stud - \$15 per class) (Junior Judges- \$5) (Junior Handler- \$5) (Led Steer/ Heifer - \$10 per animal) (Led Stud Bull/ Heifer - \$20 per animal) and are all to be paid with nominations.
- Classes have 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place only unless specified otherwise. Prizes are to the value of stated amounts (Cash and/or goods/products).
- Exhibitors are invited to attend an official presentation of trophies for the cattle sections at the undercover arena at the cattle section after judging is completed on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> of June 2026 approximately 1pm.

- Any dispute that may arise other than Judge's decisions shall be decided by not less than three members of the Cattle Committee & in conjunction with protest regulation at the front of the book.
- All stud cattle to be registered with their recognised breed society.
- All cattle are to be exhibitor bred.
- Registration certificates to be shown on pen gates, photocopies will suffice.
- Heifers to mean females that have never had a calf.
- All cattle are to be free of visible ticks and injuries or sickness.
- Cattle will be displayed and judged in pens and therefore need not be halter broken.
- Championships will be judged from first placings in single classes.
- The most successful competitor will be calculated on the following basis: First 3 points; Second 2 points; Third 1 point.
- Ribbons are issued to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place after judging.
- ALL CATTLE TO BE DE-HORNED, EXCEPT HEAVIEST BULLOCK WHICH MUST BE HORN TIPPED.
- ALL CATTLE MUST BE FREE OF TICK.
- WILD AND FRACTIOUS CATTLE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- Each entrant must familiarize themselves with the different breeds of cattle.
- Entries nominated in the wrong class may not be judged and you will forfeit your entry fees. One animal per class to be entered (One animal cannot be nominated in multiple classes.)
- If any changes are to be made, it is up to the discretion of the section steward and the Judge.

## **BREED INDEX**

Entries nominated in the wrong class may not be judged and you will forfeit your entry fees. (If any changes are to be made, it is up to the discretion of the section steward and the Judge). **Animals that are over 75% Bos Taurus genetics will be classed as a Bos Taurus.**

**(BOS INDICUS)** Brahman, Droughtmaster, Santa Gertrudis, Braford, Brangus, Charbray, Belmont Reds etc.

**(BOS TAURUS)** Angus, Charalais, Dexter, Hereford, Limousin, Murrey Grey, Romagnola, Simmental, Shorthorn, Wagyu, Lowline, Speckle Park, Texas Longhorn etc.
